Full-time Academic Positions in Chinese Language and Literature (Academic Year 2019/2020)

The Department of Chinese Language and Literature invites applications for two full-time positions of Professor in literature and classical studies of ancient China. Applicants should 1. possess a doctorate in literature of ancient China or related disciplines; 2. Either i) full Professor in literature: be capable of offering courses on *Wenxin Diaolong* 文心雕龍, Essays of the Tang and Song Dynasties, Literary Criticism, *Lunyu* 論語 as well as related elective courses; Or ii) full Professor in classical studies: Guided Readings of the Chinese Classics, *Shijing* 詩經, *Shiji* 史記, *Zuozhuan* 左傳 as well as related elective courses; 3. have at least eight years of competent university-level teaching experience as either Professor or Associate Professor; 4. have a good record of publications; 5. have three recommendations from relevant experts with full Professor title.
