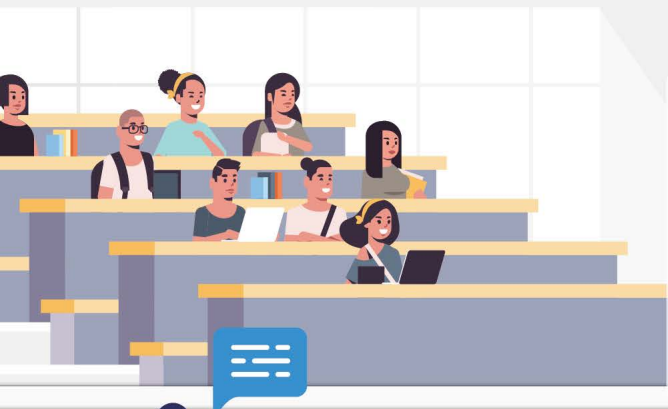

Thinking about doing a minor but not sure where to start?
We’re here to answer your questions!



What is a Minor Programme?

Most programmes at HKSYU include at least 15 credits of free electives (non-departmental electives). If you use these credits wisely, you can complete a Minor Programme!

To check whether your current major allows for a minor, you can refer to the Undergraduate Programme List on the Registry's website, or check the graduation credit requirements listed by your department.

What minors can I choose from?

We currently offer 15 different Minor Programmes! You can find the full list of available minors and the course details by scanning the QR code below.

What do I need to do to complete a minor?

To complete a minor, you must fulfill the specific subject requirements set by the chosen minor programme. Some minors include compulsory courses. Please note: only courses officially listed under a minor programme count toward its completion.

Can I minor in the same programme as my major?

No, minors must be outside of your major programme.

Is a minor the same as a double major?

Nope! A minor is not the same as a double major.

Will completing a minor give me a professional qualification?

Minors do not lead to professional certification, but they're great for building knowledge in a second area of interest, which can help with further study or career development.

Can I change my minor?

Yes—but only before formally declaring your minor (in Year 4, Semester 2). Until then, you can use your free elective credits to explore different minors. Just make sure you'll still be able to complete all the required courses in one Minor Programme in time. We recommend checking with your department before switching.

What if I don't finish all 15 credits for the minor?

No worries! Any completed courses will still count toward your free elective credits.

Can I transfer credits from previous studies or exchange programmes?

Yes! With approval from the department head of your chosen Minor Programme, you can transfer up to 6 credits from prior study or overseas exchange toward your minor.

Can a course that counts toward my major also count toward a minor?

In some cases, yes. You may double-count up to 6 credits between your major and minor programmes.



I'm interested! How do I get started?

For Year 1 entrants:

Express interest in pursuing a Minor and prioritize the elective choices for Minor studies at the beginning of Semester 2. From Year 2 to Year 4, you'll gradually complete five required courses.

For Year 2 and Year 3 entrants:

Express interest in pursuing a Minor and prioritize the elective choices for Minor studies upon admissions in late August.
