Full-time Academic Positions in Accounting

The Department of Accounting invites applications for the position for full-time/part-time lecturer / senior lecturer / assistant professor/associate professor / professor, with employment beginning in September 2024. Academic rank and salary will be commensurate with qualifications, experience, and academic achievements. Candidates must have a PhD in accounting prior to employment and a strong commitment to teaching, research, and service. Candidates for the associate professor / professor position must have a significant track record in high-quality research, demonstrated teaching excellence, and service experience. Proficiency in English is required, while proficiency in Chinese will be an advantage. The appointment is contract-based and renewable upon mutual agreement.

Responsibilities include teaching, research, and service: (1) Teaching courses in areas such as forensic accounting, auditing, accounting information systems, business analytics and statistics, taxes and business strategy, corporate finance, and/or professional ethics and corporate governance. (2) Conducting accounting research and publishing in peer-refereed journals. (3) Participating in service to the department and the university, including program development and accreditation, professional activities and events, and student activities.

Candidates for the position of assistant/associate professor of practice will be considered on the basis of the following required qualifications: (i) preferably a doctorate in accounting, (ii) professional certification such as CPA, (iii) at least 10 years of teaching experience, (iv) at least 10 years of excellent professional practice, (v) evidence of recognized contributions to the field in terms of practice and education of the accounting profession, (vi) evidence of being recognized as a respectable practitioner in the accounting profession with demonstrated involvement in professional societies. Primary responsibilities will mainly be to teach as assigned by the department, conduct applied research in accounting and publish in peer-refereed journals, provide service to the department and the university, participate in program development and accreditation, professional activities and events, and student activities.
