Position: Part-time Research Assistant

Project Title: Constructing a Narrative Corpus of Mandarin-speaking Immigrants in Hong Kong

Principal Investigator: Dr Yike Yang

The appointment will be made on a part-time basis starting from August 2024, with a possibility of renewal (subject to funding availability and mutual agreement). The remuneration will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Requirements

The applicant should have: 1) a bachelor degree or above in linguistics, speech science, Chinese, psychology or a related discipline, preferably with a concentration in language acquisition, psycholinguistics, or corpus linguistics; 2) enthusiasm for linguistics research, preferably with some relevant publication record; 3) an excellent command of spoken and written Chinese (including Cantonese and Mandarin) and English; 4) strong communication and interpersonal skills, preferably with experience in administering behavioural experiments; 5) preferably experience with tools such as Clan and Python; 6) diligence, responsibility and thoroughness towards work.

Responsibilities

The applicant will be responsible for the following tasks: 1) recruiting and identifying eligible participants for this project and performing data collection; 2) processing and annotating the collected data and performing preliminary analyses; 3) constructing the corpus; 4) writing up research reports; and 5) other research and administrative duties as assigned by the Principal Investigator.
