Requirements

Applicants should have: (i) preferably a bachelor/master degree in social science or related discipline; (ii) strong background in quantitative research methods and statistical techniques; (iii) proficiency in common computer software applications; (vi) ability to work independently and collaboratively; and (v) good written and oral communication skills in English and Chinese.
