The Arts, Culture and Technology (ACT) Programme of the Department of Sociology invites applications for a visiting professorship (1-4 months) within the period Jan to August 2026. Rank will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. Candidates should have extensive research and teaching experience at the university level, with a track record of expertise in generative AI and/or metaverse technologies. Candidates will be expected to make contributions to teaching and research in the following broad fields of specialization:

Digital Heritage, Geographic Information System (GIS), Heritage Studies, 3D Modelling, VR/AR, Cultural Computing, Cultural Technology, and Digital Humanities.

The programme in Arts, Culture and Technology seeks to bridge knowledge of arts and culture with digital innovation. It delves into the dynamics of how arts, culture and technology impact society, and vice versa. Faculty of the new programme are expected to take an interdisciplinary approach to teaching and research, and should be adept at navigating the disruptive effects of digital technology in the arts and culture sector and related industries.

Candidates are expected to have extensive experience in teaching and curriculum development, as well as a good track record in research and publication. Faculty members on sabbatical from their home institutions are welcome. Proficiency in English is required, while proficiency in Chinese will be an advantage.
