

The Arts, Culture and Technology (ACT) Programme of the Department of Sociology is inviting applications for a full-time Assistant/Associate Professor position to start in January 2027. Rank will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. Candidates should demonstrate the ability to effectively teach at the undergraduate level while pursuing an active research agenda. Candidates should possess a PhD degree in Computer Engineering, 3D Imaging, VR/AR, Photogrammetry, or relevant disciplines, and will be expected to make contributions to teaching and research in Digital Technology/3D Imaging. The candidate will be expected to teach courses in 3D data acquisition and processing, which may include Terrestrial LiDAR scanning, Drone surveys, 3D close-range photogrammetry techniques and immersive applications (e.g., Unity, Unreal and Blender). Candidates with experience in the application of 3D imaging technology to the art, culture and heritage sectors will have an advantage.

The ACT programme seeks to bridge knowledge of arts and culture with digital innovation. It delves into the dynamics of how arts, culture and technology impact society, and vice versa. Faculty members of the ACT programme are expected to take an interdisciplinary approach to teaching and research,

Preference will be given to applicants who have at least two years of teaching experience and a good track record in research and publication. Proficiency in English is required, while proficiency in Chinese will be an advantage.
