Job Duties

The appointee will assist in implementing an RGC funded project entitled “Mapping the grey digital divide and diversity in older ICT users post-COVID: A mixed-method research informing service and policy development” undertaken by Dr. Lau Hi Po of the Department of Counselling and Psychology & Centre for Interdisciplinary Evidence-based Practice & Research.

He/she will be responsible for the following tasks:

- (a) literature review;
- (b) data collection and data analysis;
- (c) conduct and organize social impact activities ;
- (d) drafting academic manuscripts and editorials; and
- (e) other research and administrative duties as assigned by the Principal Investigator and the Co-Principal Investigators.

Requirements

Applicants should have: (i) preferably a bachelor’s degree in Psychology, social work or public health or related discipline; (ii) strong background in quantitative or qualitative data analysis; (iii) proficiency in writing academic manuscripts; (iv) ability to work independently and collaboratively; and (v) good written and oral communication skills in English and Chinese.

The appointment will be made on the basis of a three-year contract, with a possibility of renewal, subject to mutual agreement and funding availability. The remuneration package will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.
