Job Duties

The appointee will be responsible for (a) conducting quantitative and qualitative research studies, including research design, data collection, analysis, compilation of reports and other forms of deliverables; (b) providing administrative support to the laboratory manager and directors; (c) Preparing literature review regarding neuroscience and forensic psychology; (d) compiling progress reports and the final report; (e) assisting the publications and other related research work in the laboratory; (f) maintaining laboratory equipment and ensure compliance with safety protocols; and (g) assisting with course tutorials and preparation. Supportive supervision will be provided upon appointment.

Requirements

Applicants should have

- (a) bachelor's degree in Psychology or a related field;
- (b) excellent command of SPSS;
- (c) good skills in psychology- related data collection;
- (d) excellent command of English and Chinese language (Cantonese);
- (e) personal quality of good responsibility, industriousness and readiness to learn and to help other people.

(2) Lab Manager

Job Duties

The appointee will be responsible for (a) overseeing daily laboratory operations and ensuring compliance with safety regulations; (b) managing budgets, resources, and inventory of laboratory supplies and equipment; (c) coordinating research projects, including planning, execution, and data analysis; (d) supervising and training lab assistant and interns, providing mentorship and guidance; (e) facilitating collaboration among researchers and external partners; and (f) assisting with course tutorials and preparation.

Requirements

Applicants should have

- (a) master's degree or PhD in Psychology, Neuroscience, or a related field;
- (b) experience in laboratory management and research coordination;
- (c) excellent command of SPSS and familiarity with research methodologies and data analysis techniques;
- (d) strong leadership skills with the ability to mentor and motivate staff;
- (e) excellent organizational and communication skills.
