The appointees are expected to provide research supervision to students at undergraduate and postgraduate levels. The academic rank offered will be commensurate with the academic and/or clinical background and experience of the successful candidate.

Senior Lecturer: Doctorate degree with relevant teaching/supervision experience

Assistant Professor: Doctorate degree obtained with a record of research in refereed publications plus at least one year of satisfactory fulltime degree-level teaching performance

Associate Professor: Relevant doctorate, a solid record of research and publications, plus at least five years of satisfactory performance at Assistant Professor Level
