Position: Full-time Research Assistant

Job Duties

The appointee will assist in implementing an RGC funded project entitled “Stress-Buffering Effects of Coping Strategies and Social Supports on Psychological Distress: A Longitudinal Panel Study of the Antecedents of Problematic Social Media Use” undertaken by Professor Louis Leung of the Department of Applied Data Science.

He/she will be responsible for the following tasks:

- (a) literature review;
- (b) data collection and data analysis;
- (c) planning and conducting focus groups;
- (d) designing and preparing questionnaires;
- (e) conducting pilot testing of survey instruments;
- (f) supervising student helpers in data collection and data entry;
- (g) drafting research report; and
- (h) other research and administrative duties as assigned by the Principal Investigator.

Requirements

Applicants should have: (i) preferably a master degree in social science or related discipline; (ii) strong background in quantitative research methods and statistical techniques; (iii) proficiency in common computer software applications; (iv) ability to work independently and collaboratively; and (v) good written and oral communication skills in English and Chinese.

Terms and Conditions

The appointment will be made on the basis of a one-year contract, with a possibility of renewal, subject to mutual agreement and funding availability. The remuneration package will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.
