### **Job Duties**

The appointee will be responsible for (a) conducting quantitative and qualitative research studies relating to the project, including literature review, research design, data collection, analysis, compilation of reports and other forms of deliverables; (b) providing administrative support to the research team; (c) assisting the PI to design and facilitate individual and group life-design vocational counselling programmes for rehabilitated drug abusers; (d) compiling progress reports and the final report; (e) assisting in the publications of findings of the project; and (f) assisting in other related research work as prescribed by the PI and Co-PI.

### **Requirements**

- (a) a Bachelor's degree or a master degree in psychology, counselling or counselling psychology;
- (b) good command of SPSS;
