### **Position: Full-time Research Assistant**

#### **Job Duties**

The appointee will assist in implementing an RGC funded project entitled “Shifting Strategies and Coalition Dynamics of the Pro-Democracy Movement in Hong Kong: The Role of Perceived Opportunities and Threats” undertaken by Dr LI Hang of the Department of Sociology. He/she will be involved in (a) data collection using qualitative methodology; (b) archival research; (c) data entry and analysis using NVivo; (d) transcription; and (e) other research and administrative duties as assigned.

#### **Requirements**

Applicants should have: (i) a Bachelor’s degree or above in sociology, political science, or related discipline; (ii) experience in qualitative research and archival research; (iii) proficiency in common computer software applications; (iv) a good command of interpersonal and communication skills in external liaison; and (v) ability to work independently and collaboratively.

Appointment will initially be made on contract basis for one year, renewable subject to good performance and mutual agreement.
